Frankenstein's Clay Creations (6yrs+)

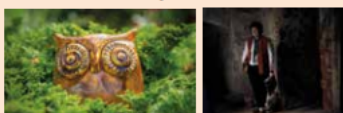

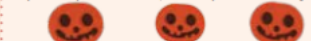
Get spooky making your own ghostly ship and haunted house using range of arty techniques

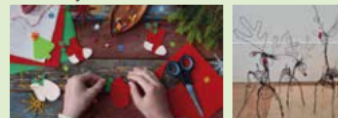
