



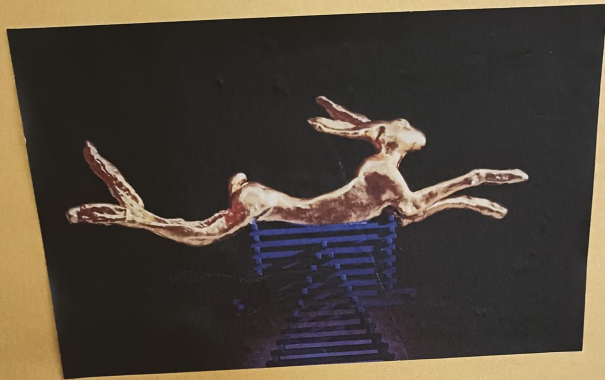

We have made clay models of Barnabus-a failed pet from the Barnabus project. He is a mixture between a mouse and an elephant







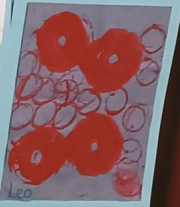
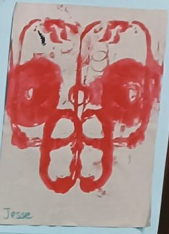




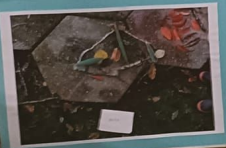

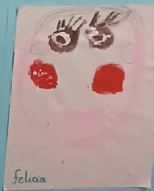
The children mixed the primary colours red, blue and yellow to make the colour of their choice.
